INTRODUCTION: ENCOURAGING AIR LIQUIDE EMPLOYEES TO GET INVOLVED IN LOCAL INITIATIVES

- as part of the Citizen at Work program* (during working hours)
- during working hours, with the agreement of their manager (during working hours)
- during a team building (during working hours)
- by volunteering (on their free time)

*Citizen at Work is an engaging program created by the Air Liquide Group to enable employees to dedicate a portion of their working hours to lend a helping hand to their local communities.

POSSIBLE VOLUNTEERING ROLES FOR AIR LIQUIDE EMPLOYEES

- Air Liquide employees have the opportunity to get involved and support an association:
 Individually or as part of a team
 Through their human or professional skills
 Temporarily (half a day) or permanently (for example: 2 hours every 2 months; 2 times a day, etc.)
 Close to their place of work or home
 On site or remotely
